HAGERSTOWN CLUB-CHAMPIONS BLUE RIDGE LEAGUE, 1929.

BLUE RIDGE LEAGUE

Hagerstown won the first half of the championship season of the Blue Ridge League and the second half was won by Martinsburg. In the play-off Hagerstown was successful, winning four games of the six played. The season was interesting; the league had some situations to meet that were trying, but the organization met them well. Clubs of the American League have interests in the circuit and they have given aid when it was needed.

Cramer of Martinsburg, a player much sought for, who batted 404 in 104 games, was the batting champion of the circuit. A major league future is predicted for him. The second best batter was Vosmik of Frederick with a batting percentage of 331 in 112 games. Neither Martinsburg nor Frederick led in team batting, but the Hanover club did and Martinsburg ran second.

However, Martinsburg led in team fielding.

Biot of Frederick was the leading pitcher on the basis of victories and defeats. He pitched thirteen winning games and lost three. Gilbert of Hagerstown was second best. Two or three of the Blue Ridge pitchers went over into major league company. The season finished with such success that a better record is expected this year. The executive affairs of the league have always been ably handled.
