BLUE RIDGE LEAGUE

Hanover, in Maryland, won the championship of the Blue Ridge League in the play-off. The team meeting Hanover was Chambersburg, and the latter won one game of the five that were played. The leading batter of the six-club circuit was Hammen, first basemen of Hanover, with a percentage of .355. The leading pitcher was Blake of Chambersburg, who won 17 games and lost five. Blake was given his record because he played in 15 or more games. Howser of the same team was practically as good, with a record of 11 victories and 3 defeats.

The season might have been better, but this league has made a reputation for good Base Ball and capital handling that has made it possible to weather more than one storm that threatened it in the past. It was reported after the season ended that the New York American League club would purchase the Chambersburg franchise and operate that club as a feeder and training ground for the Yankees. The quality of Base Ball played in the league is so good that major managers are not loathe to send their surplus players to the circuit for further improvement.
