Notes - From The Public Opinion, "Regular Thriller Was B.B. Game on Cold May Evening," Chambersburg rallied for two runs in the ninth to tie the game, and scored the winning run in the 10th over the visiting Ponies from Gettysburg. Ed Stricker got his first win of the season, pitching all 10 innings. James "Bugs" Snyder knocked in Bill Pedone with the winning run in extra innings. Clean-up hitter Kolseth hammered one of Bill Jameson's spitters, scoring Earl Clauser. "Koly" scored the tying run on a slow roller by Eddie Hooper, who easily beat the throw to first, allowing the Maroons to knot the score.

The game featured a short rain delay in the seventh with the Ponies at bat. The game resumed after a rainbow appeared. The first batter up after the delay, Art Kohler, knocked the first pitch for a base hit, scoring Stein to tie the game at two. Herman advanced Kohler to third on a hit-and-run play, forcing Stricker to give Stevens a free pass to fill the bases. Bill Jameson then tapped a slow roller to Hooper, who slipped on the wet grass, and threw the ball over Kolseth's head, allowing Kohler and Herman to score.

Notes - Chambersburg pitcher Doc Milliman was confined to bed with an injury to his leg he received in the Maroons opening game vs Hagerstown. Gettysburg Manager Ira Plank was not present during the Chambersburg road trip, as he also served as the Varsity Coach for the Gettysburg College baseball team. Captain "Art" Herman filled in for Plank during these two games.
