Notes - From *The Public Opinion*, "Maroons Take 4-3 Game from Ponies." Chambersburg held off a ninth inning comeback by the Ponies, to edge the Battlefield Boys 4 to 3 at Wolf Park. Arthur Stevens pitched for the Maroons, and according to the paper "had a lot of smoke for a small man." He held Gettysburg on two hits until the ninth, when the Ponies reached him for two doubles, a triple, and three runs across the plate.

The Maroons scored first in the third, when George Pedone reached safely on a dribbler down the first base line. Bugs Snyder tried to a sacrifice him, but reached safely for a hit. After a sacrifice by Earl Clauser, Karl Kolseth grounded out to first, allowing Pedone to score from third. The Maroons added three more tallies in the fourth. Ben Mallonee led off with a base hit along the rightfield foul line. Port sacrificed him to second, and reach safely when Gettys throw was off the mark. Pitcher Stevens hit one to hot for "Art" Herman to handle, and Mallonee crossed the plate with the Maroons second run.

Pedone tapped an infield hit to load the bases, and Bugs Snyder knocked Port in on a sacrifice fly. Karl Kolseth added another run when he knocked in Stevens to give Chambersburg a 4 to 0 lead.

All was quiet until the top of the ninth, when the Ponies bats came alive. Stein opened with a single, and advanced on an infield out. Art Kohler rapped a two bagger to score Stein, and scored himself when Herman struck "a noisy blow into right" for a triple. Muff Oyler, pinch hitting for Gettys, cashed in Herman when he doubled to left. The rally ended when "Eddie" Copeland lined to Mallonee' in center.
