"Lefty" Heller tossed a one-hitter, and "Gus" Boyne hit a home run, as Gettysburg blanked Hanover, 3 to 0 at McAllister Field on Friday evening.

"Gus" Boyne led off the scoring with a solo home run off Warden in the third inning. In the sixthm Boyne was safe on Caddin's error, took second on Bigler's sacrifice bunt, and scored on Art Koehler's base hit. Boyne scored again in the eighth, reaching on a single, taking second on another Bigler sacrifice, and scoring on Ira Plank's base hit.

The fielding of Ponies shortstop Leo Seiffert also featured, as he stabbed Billy Starr's hot line drive, with Rooney on third to prevent the Raiders from scoring in the second. "Pete" Bigler stopped a Raiders rally in the seventh, when he stopped Rooney's line drive at third, forcing out Spencer at second.

Roy Durborrow stole second and tried to steal third base in the third inning, but Umpire Raphun called him out, despite the disagreement from the Ponies bench.

*Notes* - Detroit Tigers scout, Joe Sudgen umpired the remainder of the game, after Raphun was hit in the heart by a foul tip, and had to be taken from the field. The game was called before the start of the ninth inning, on account of darkness.
