Notes - *From The Martinsburg Journal*, "GOODWIN BLANKS HANOVER IN THAT TOWN BY WORKING FINE BALL THROUGHOUT GAME...Hagerstown Wins From Lowly Ponies and Moves Into Second Place - Chambersburg Continues Her Drive By Taking One From Frederick - Three Teams Now Bunched Behind Leaders."

Martinsburg southpaw, Marvin Goodwin held Hanover to three well-scattered hits, as the Mountaineers blanked the Raiders, 4 to 0 at McAllister Field in Hanover, Pennsylvania on Wednesday evening.

The game was pitted as a pitcher's duel between two of the top left-handed pitchers in the league, Goodwin and Hanover ace, Willie Scherdel, who would later go on to successful Major League careers. Good win would come out on top, baffling the Raiders batters throughout the game.

Martinsburg picked at Scherdel's offering, scoring a run in the second when John Bates tripled, and scored on Country Morris' sacrifice fly. The following inning, Reggie Rawlings led off with a triple off "Wee Willie", and scored on John Bates' base hit.

In the fifth, Country Morris homered off of one of Scherdel's fastballs to give Martinsburg a 3-0 lead. The Mountaineers rounded out the scoring in the eight when Rawlings' walked, and scored on Bates' three-bagger.
