Notes - From The News, "Stair Overcomes Heat' Gettysburg's Bill Stair overcome a stifling heat wave in a hotly contested game versus Martinsburg, to defeat the Champions, 3 to 1 on Monday afternoon at Willow Lane Park. Stair picked up the win despite having to leave in the eighth inning due to heat exhaustion. He was relieved in the ninth inning by John Lower to finished the game, saving the win for the Patriots, despite loading the bases, and having Paul "Muff" Oyler make a diving catch on Donnelly's line drive to end the game.

Johnny Mumford started for Martinsburg but was tossed out of the game in the eighth inning after arguing with Umpire Gene Hanks on a disputed play that allowed the winning run to score. Jerry Jarosick played spoiler for Gettysburg in the bottom of the eighth, knocking in teammate Kelly on a close play at the plate, that most of the fans and Mumford thought should have gone the other way. Mumford argued the call, and was fined and ejected from the game for his abusive behavior. A unprepared Finney Kelly came in relief, and gave up a single to Paddy Kane, which knocked in Jarosick with another run for Gettysburg.

Notes – Due to a scheduling conflict at Nixon Field with the Gettysburg College baseball team, Ira Plank was forced to move this came to Willow Lane Park in Hagerstown, MD. Plank did not travel with the team for this game, as he was coaching the Gettysburg College nine.
