Notes - From The News, "Hooray! Martinsburg Wins. " Gettysburg needed three pitchers in an ineffectual effort to stop Martinsburg's savage hitting, as the Champions edged the Patriots, 9 to 8 on Tuesday at Hagerstown's Willow Lane Park.

Gettysburg rallied for four runs in the eighth inning off Martinsburg starter, Finney Kelly, to knock him from the box, forcing Manager "Counry" Morris to bring in reliever Frank Hoffecker, who picked up the win. Martinsburg scored the winning run in the bottom of the eighth on two singles and a sacrifice.

Notes – Due to a scheduling conflict at Nixon Field with the Gettysburg College baseball team, Ira Plank was forced to move this game to Willow Lane Park in Hagerstown, MD. Plank did not travel with the team for this game, as he was coaching the Gettysburg College nine. This was the second game between these two clubs played in Hagerstown.
